A proposal may be in the process of being introduced and coming before the State General Assembly in January. It will deal with the amount of money Red Bank receives from the State Shared Sales Tax revenue.

Hamilton County Mayor Jim Coppinger has proposed a plan that **IF PASSED, WOULD RESULT IN EITHER YOUR PROPERTY TAXES BEING INCREASED NEXT YEAR OR SOME CITY SERVICES BEING REDUCED OR ELIMINATED.**
