

**RESOLUTION NO. 25-1786**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF RED BANK, TENNESSEE AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE PROJECT DIABETES GRANT IN AN AMOUNT OF UP TO \$150,000.00 PER YEAR FOR THREE YEARS FOR A POSSIBLE TOTAL OF \$450,000.00 FOR THE PARKS AND RECREATION DIVISION WITH NO MATCH REQUIREMENT IF AWARDED**

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission adopted as a 2025 Commission Goal to develop parks, trails, and recreation services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission adopted as 2026 Commission Goals the implementation of the Parks Master Plan and low-cost activation of city property by making improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tennessee Department of Health's Project Diabetes Grant provides funding for primary prevention projects that aim to reduce the incidence of chronic disease through policy, systems, and environmental changes; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Red Bank seeks to apply for funding under Project Diabetes in Category A for up to \$150,000.00 per year for three years to support the development of the Godsey Ridge Trail and the supporting amenities around it, enhancing access to physical activity opportunities for residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Red Bank would use these funds to construct and improve trail infrastructure, install wayfinding signage, add seating areas, and implement other necessary amenities to create a safe and accessible recreational environment; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Red Bank is eligible to apply for the Project Diabetes Grant under category A; and

**WHEREAS**, there is no requirement for any matching amount to be contributed by the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Manager or his designee to apply for the Project Diabetes Grant, funding to begin in Fiscal Year 2026.
