

RESOLUTION NO. 25-1821

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF RED BANK, TENNESSEE, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH 2025-2028 PROJECT DIABETES GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF UP TO \$402,300.00 WITH NO MATCH REQUIREMENT

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted as a 2025 Commission Goal to develop parks, trails, and recreation services; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted as 2026 Commission Goals the implementation of the Parks Master Plan and low-cost activation of city property by making improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Department of Health's Project Diabetes Grant provides funding for primary prevention projects that aim to reduce the incidence of chronic disease through policy, systems, and environmental changes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Red Bank did submit an application to the 2025 - 2028 Project Diabetes Grant Program under the authorization of Resolution No. 25-1786, requesting funding in the amount of \$402,300.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of Red Bank has been awarded funding for the 2025 - 2028 Project Diabetes Grant, which will cover a three-year period with no requirement of any matching amount to be contributed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Red Bank will use these funds over the next three years to construct the Godsey Ridge trail system, update and add parking at the Community Center, add sidewalks, safe crossings, and curb cuts for safe access to Godsey Ridge, the Red Bank Pool, Red Bank Community Center, and Red Bank Middle/High Schools.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Red Bank Board of Commissioners does hereby authorize the City Manager to accept the Tennessee Department of Health 2025 - 2028 Project Diabetes Grant award in the amount up to \$402,300.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to sign and execute the Grant Agreement, upon approval of the form by the City Attorney.
