

**ORDINANCE NO. 17-1087**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RED BANK, TENNESSEE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 15-1043, CODIFIED AT RED BANK CITY CODE TITLE 15, CHAPTER 15, SECTION 15-108, SECTION 15-109(4) AND SECTION 15-117 IN ORDER TO FURTHER DEFINE MOBILE FOOD SERVICE VEHICLE ZONES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Red Bank, Tennessee, as follows:

Section 1. Red Bank City Code Title 15, Chapter 15, Section 15-108(2) shall be revised by changing the lawful hours of operation to end at 9:00 p.m. instead of 8:00 p.m. as presently provided.

Section 2. Red Bank City Code Title 15, Chapter 15, Section 109(4) shall be revised by changing the requirement that vending activity shall end by 9:00 p.m. instead of 10:00 p.m. as presently provided.

Section 3. Red Bank City Code Title 15, Chapter 15, Section 15-117(a)(1) is deleted as written and substituted in its place and stead the following (a)(1) as follows:

- 1) Those areas defined as Zone C-1 and Zone C-2 in the Red Bank Zoning Ordinance but only to the extent that the said C-1 and C-2 zones adjoin and are immediately adjacent to Dayton Boulevard and at no other locations and along no other streets, roads or thoroughfares within Zones C-1 and/or C-2.

Section 4. Every section, sentence, clause, and phrase of this Ordinance is separable and severable. Should any section, sentence, clause, or phrase be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, said unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not effect or impair any other section, sentence, clause, or phrase.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days from the date of its passage upon second and final reading, the welfare of the citizens of the City of Red Bank requiring it.
